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Coating Procedure	 Apply a contact layer of StoCrete 372 onto the substrate using the flat edge of the trowel. Then comb more materials on the surface using a suitable notched trowel to achieve an even setting bed. Do not prepare more than approx. 1.5 m² of material required. Lay tiles using sliding pressure and position tiles before skin forms on the adhesive. Do not attempt to wet the adhesive when skin has formed instead it can be touch-up by respreading with the notched trowel. Scrape off surplus adhesive on the tile surface or between joints before it hardens.
